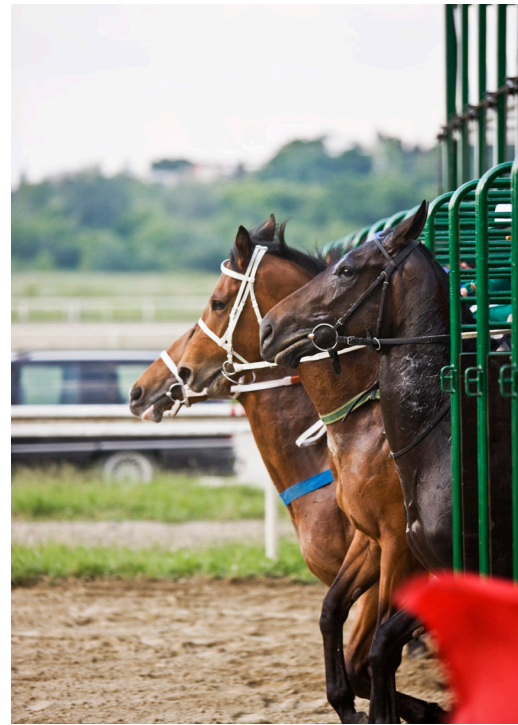
### ANIMAL SCIENCES B.S. RACE TRACK INDUSTRY PROGRAM

The Race Track Industry Program is the only program of its kind offering a bachelor's and master's degree centered on the racing industry. It offers two paths of study: one preparing students for race track management, regulation, or pari-mutuel racing organizations; the other preparing students for employment in areas dealing with racing and breeding animals.

### TRANSFER EQUIVALENCIES

On the following page you will find course equivalencies for the **Animal Sciences: Race Track Industry Program** emphasis. The information presented is a recommended outline of courses for students to take at Pima Community College that will transfer as equivalent courses to the University of Arizona. Please consult with a transfer admissions counselor and academic advisor to review specific courses as transfer pathways are subject to change.

The course equivalencies on the following page are from the AZTransfer course equivalency guide. The student's successful completion of each course will be reviewed in the pre-admission evaluation. Please note that all course work will be officially evaluated once your official transcript is processed by the University of Arizona. Students must receive a grade of a C or higher for a course to transfer.



In the Race Track Industry Program, students will take classes such as **Race Track Marketing and Media Relations** and **Racing Laws and Enforcement** to give them a well-rounded perspective on the industry.
